American Explorer Motorcoach eventually grew to the the point where it became necessary to be a stand alone company. While we still provide transportation for Project Exploration, We are certified and licensed to operate as a charter bus company.
4.1.2. American Explorer Motorcoach provides safe, reliable, and comfortable motor coach transportation for tens of thousands of eager travelers each year. We have done so now for over 23 years. Our reputation for safe, reliable and courteous drivers coupled with clean, quality buses is unimpeachable. Please note that for the past several years American Explorer has provided top-notch service to such clients as MCCCD, Chandler Unified School District (sole-provider for 4 years, bus charter), Mesa Unified School District, and Paradise Valley Unified School District.

### 4.2 Specific Requirements

4.2.1. American Explorer Motorcoach has a majority of buses that are newer than 8 years old. We are enclosing data sheets on all of the buses that we feel will serve the MCCCD needs. All of our buses are maintained to the highest industry standards with mandated "A" and "B" and annual inspections performed by our certified mechanics. Additionally, regular maintenance is performed when necessary as reported by drivers in Pre-Trip and Post Trip Inspections. Additional maintenance documentation may be provided upon request.
4.2.2. American Explorer complies will all DOT regulations.
4.2.3. American Explorer has 6 ADA equipped buses. They will be made available when the need arises for MCCCD.
4.2.4. All of American Explorer Motorcoaches are equipped with DVD and Audio/video equipment.
4.2.5 American Explorer buses are equipped with good restrooms and we will commit to service them daily on multiple day trips.
4.2.6 American Explorer understands that large motorcoaches have a minimum seating capacity of 45 and that small/mini buses shall be 15-34 seats, and that vans will carry fewer than 15 passengers.
4.2.7. American Explorer commits that our drivers will comply will all DOT standards for coach operation. Additionally, our drivers will be uniformed and will display company identification.
4.2.8 American Explorer motor coaches will be available to MCCCD 24 hours/day, 7 days/week.
4.2.9 American Explorer takes great pride in professionally handling breakdowns, road closures, and other unforeseen trip delays. American Explorer maintains $24 / 7$ mechanics on-call rotation and will network with mobile mechanics as well as other bus companies to rescue the passengers from prolonged delays.

In the event of vehicle failure the following steps are to be followed by the driver:
-The first step is to make sure the passengers are in the safest location possible.
-The driver then calls our dispatch line (on call 24/7) to inform them of the situation. dispatch will work with the office staff to find a replacement bus immediately. Time is
of the essence and we want to have a replacement as quickly as possible. We will send our own bus when possible and we partner with companies in different locations to help when we have an emergency. Individuals from Dispatch, Shop and Safety are CDL Licensed and able to help deliver a bus when necessary.

The driver then calls an on call mechanic number(The lead mechanic to make an assessment of the situation). They have access to several 24 hour bus services such as MCI and Provost Emergency services that will help when we need to get the bus going as quickly as possible.

Working from these 2 angles we hope to have the situation resolved in a timely manor and the group back on the road.

While breakdowns are and inevitable part of the business we pride ourselves on low breakdown ratios. We also evaluated each breakdown after the incident to evaluate what was done right and what can be improved upon or eliminated.
4.2.10 American Explorer commits to spot buses a minimum of 15 minutes prior to scheduled departure time.
4.2.11.American Explorer understands the importance of arriving to pick up passengers with a clean bus including interior, restroom, and windows. We always keep certified fire extinguishers and first aid kits on all of our buses.
4.2.12.American Explorer does not currently have any buses with casino or inappropriate advertising anywhere on the buses. We have no plans to adorn our buses with such advertising and will commit to never send such buses to pick up MCCCD passengers.
4.2.13 A drivers Workday is defined by MCCCD, American Explorer Motorcoach and Federal Mandate as being no more than 10 hours of drive time
4.2.14 If a vehicle is booked (meaning confirmation is received in the form of a charter number by booking party) American Explorer Motorcoach will always honor that booking. In the event that bus is not available for unforeseen circumstances, a replacement vehicle will be provided at no additional cost to MCCCD.
4.2.15 On Multi-day trips, driver's accommodations and per dim will abide by MCCCD's Travel Administrative Regulations.

5.2.1 American Explorer Motorcoach is a primary transportation provider for local elementary and high school districts such as Chandler Unified, Paradise Valley Unified, Gilbert public schools and Mesa Public Schools.

We developed a relationship with each of these districts through hard work and great customer service. We highly encourage you to contact the districts and individuals we work with to get an idea of what American Explorer Motorcoach is all about. Following is a list of Schools and School Districts with Contact Persons.

Mesa Public Schools - We have worked with Mesa schools Since 2003. These trips include local trips as well as trips throughout the Southwest. Additionally our sister company, Project Exploration, has done many trips with Mesa Schools. These trips always include Charter Transportation provided through American Explorer Motorcoach. 5.2.2. American Explorer Motorcoach is one of only a very few bus companies to own its own bus yard. Our yard is equipped with wash and dump facilities and can handle our fleet of 25 motor coaches along with 4 other tenant coaches. We meet all OSHA guidelines and our mechanics are among the best in the industry. We are insured and certified to meet all specifications of the law. American Explorer Motorcoach operates a mixed fleet of quality equipment. Please view the enclosed informational sheets on several of our buses. All of our buses are maintained to the highest industry standards with mandated " A " and " B " as well as annual inspections performed by our certified mechanics. Additionally, regular maintenance is performed when necessary as reported by drivers in Pre-Trip and Post Trip Inspections.

Driver Training: American Explorer trains all drivers before putting them behind the wheel of a motorcoach. Each driver is given a road test and is checked on individual buses before performing safety-sensitive functions.

Proactive Functions: American Explorer holds quarterly training meeting with all drivers and offers on-going training for drivers receiving complaints from customers or staff. American Explorer requires safety video training for all drivers.

Driver Discipline: Drivers receiving complaints from customers or fellow drivers are interviewed and where necessary are written-up for discipline. Serious incidents are followed by dismissal or the suspension of driving privileges. Remedial training is required in many cases of reported breaches in policy or driving procedure.

Trainer Qualifications: Rodger Slater and Wanda Sartain serve as our driver trainers. Wanda has been a certified third party tester and Rodger has many years of safe driving on record.

Driver Evaluations: Each driver is reviewed periodically by trainers and management. Drivers are also evaluated in written form by clients.

Drug Testing: American Explorer follows all DOT prescribed protocol for drug and alcohol testing. We test drivers from a random pull for alcohol directly before a safetysensitive function and we test from the same random pull for drugs.
5.2.3 All of our buses are equipped with an ELD (Electronic Logging Device). This is a Verizon program that keeps track of drivers hours of service, driving behaviors, idle time, along with other driver behaviors. We have been able to monitor Speeding, Harsh Breaking and Excelaration, Harsh Corning, along with video monitoring each trip. The trainers are able to actively monitor each and every driver on a daily basis.

This system allows for a much more comprehensive training and monitoring program then has ever been possible. We can map the bus in real time, identify violations and review them with the driver.
5.2.4 American Explorer Motorcoach currently operates 25 luxury motor coaches. Each motor coach is equipped with reclining seats, restroom, public address systems, air conditioning, video monitors, roomy luggage bays, and overhead storage. Our mixed fleet of coaches is perfect for any traveler:

5.2.7 American Explorer Motorcoach drivers are carefully screened and road tested before being hired. We currently employ 24 full-time drivers and roughly ten parttime seasonal drivers. Because the bulk of our tour market includes young students, the drivers that we hire are screened not just for their driving skills, but also for their ability to work well with students. We pride ourselves in employing patient, student-friendly drivers. We are very proud of our equipment and our driving staff. Following are some of the ongoing practices by American Explorer Motorcoach to ensure the best team of drivers and maintenance staff possible.

Driver Training: American Explorer trains all drivers before putting them behind the wheel of a motor coach. Each driver is given a road test and goes through a standard class and video training. Additionally they are checked on individual buses before performing safety-sensitive functions. Drivers are required to complete 12 hours of training each year. Driver trainers ride along on a trip each year to insure company standards are met. The company produces safety bulletins each month and periodically sends out surveys to get client feedback.

Proactive Functions: American Explorer holds quarterly training meetings with all drivers and offers ongoing training for drivers receiving complaints from customers or staff. American Explorer requires safety video training for all drivers.

Driver Discipline: Drivers receiving complaints from customers or fellow drivers are interviewed and where necessary are written-up for discipline. Serious incidents are followed by dismissal or the suspension of driving privileges. Remedial training is required in many cases of reported breaches in policy or driving procedure.

Trainer Qualifications: Rodger Slater and Wanda Sartain serve as our driver trainers. Wanda has been a certified third party tester and Rodger has many years of safe driving on record.
Driver Evaluations: Each driver is reviewed periodically by trainers and management. Drivers are also evaluated in written form by clients.

Drug Testing: American Explorer follows all DOT prescribed protocol for drug and alcohol testing. We test drivers from a random pull for alcohol directly before a safety-sensitive function and we test from the same random pull for drugs.

## At minimum drivers must pass a level 1 finger print clearance, Pre employment drug and alcohol screening, finish company training and Have a class B commericial driver's license with a passenger endorsement.

Safety is always priority one. We train the drivers to always be conscious of safety during a trip and avoid jeopardizing the safety of students at all cost.

We pride ourselves on working to cover whatever trips come up at whatever time of the day or night. Again we would encourage the district to call the other districts we work with. Our ability to be flexible and cover every trip possible sets us apart from the rest. We do not require a set lead time. If you have a last minute trip we will work diligently to provide service.
5.3.3 We currently have 6 buses with ADA lifts. If a passenger requires and ADA lift, we are happy to accommodate the request.
5.3.4 Cancellations can be at no cost up until 2 hours prior to spot time. Cancellations done 0 2 hours prior to spot time will incur a $\$ 250$ charge.
5.3.5 American Explorer Motorcoach defines a standard day the same as MCCCCD. 10 hours
