Option B includes an irrigation tech on the property at least once a month for 4 hours a month. This includes monitoring the system and making adjustments as needed.





Landscaping Maintenance Scope of Work

Outdoor Systems Management (OSM) shall furnish all horticultural supervision, professional recommendations, labor, materials, equipment, disposal, and transportation required to maintain the landscape throughout the contracted period, as specified herein. The scope of our services shall be based exclusively on those items approved and initialed on the following Proposal Document and shall never deviate from the standard scope unless agreed upon in writing by both parties.

Lawn Care Lawns shall be mowed during the active growing season or on an as needed basis. During excessive rainy or dry periods, mowing will take place as conditions dictate. Mowing heights will be based on best horticulture practices, taking season and turf variety into account. Edging shall take place to maintain a neat, presentable appearance. All fertilizers will be legally applied at the contractor's discretion. The number of applications will depend on fertilizer makeup and turf variety. Fungicides and Pesticides will be recommended when necessary, but not applied until agreed upon, in writing, by both parties. All fungicides and pesticides will be legally approved and regulated. Scalping, Dethatching, & Winter Overseed included. N/A

Grounds Care All decomposed granite or mulch areas will be inspected, raked, and/or blown to ensure that the areas are kept free of debris, litter, and are maintained to presentable standards. Any weeds, invasive grasses, and undesired plant material will be removed or shall be controlled with legally approved herbicides at the contractor's discretion. Any areas with excessive infestations or mulch build up will be discussed with the client and proposed separately if necessary.

Shrubs/ Ground Cover Shrubs shall be pruned only as necessary to promote healthy, natural growth patterns. Exceptions to this includes necessary pruning due to safety/visual hazards and the removal of disease, neglected overgrowth, or dead/damaged plant material. All shrubs and groundcovers shall be maintained to avoid weed infestations and cross contamination between species. Ground covers shall be edged to keep them within boundaries, off of curbs, and out of walkways. Granite will be racked as needed.



Tree Pruning Height limitations for tree pruning covered in the speciation is 10 feet. On trees over 10 feet in height only low hanging branches that present a danger to pedestrians and vehicular traffic will be raised. Trees smaller than 10 feet are scheduled to be pruned in winter months except for safety related pruning.

Weed Control Weeds will be controlled manually or systematically with the use of legally approved **Pre-Emergent 2x per year and Post-emergent as needed**. These services may be an additional cost if not originally agreed upon in the contract. **included**

Debris Cleanup All landscape areas shall be inspected on the days of service and excess debris shall be removed. Any landscape debris generated from our maintenance service shall be removed from paved or hardscaped areas on the day of service. Exclusions from this include any non-landscape related debris, or debris within pools and/or water features.

Irrigation If applicable, watering shall be scheduled with automatic controllers to supply quantities and frequencies consistent with seasonal requirements. Exercising and adjusting drip zones will be done on a monthly basis. **Weekly irrigation checks included**.

Reporting All Reporting and photos will be done on a weekly basis
